

In their new book the artist couple Carola Vogt and Peter Boerboom have combined their two new series of photographs entitled Abenteuerland [Adventure Land] and *Bodenprobe* [Soil Sample]. In *Abenteuerland* they visualise the intertwining of current leisure trends with the well-known romanticism of forest settings. By restaging the forest setting with outdoor incentives, woodland experience trails and high-rope courses in beautiful areas as unspoilt as possible, they conjure up specifically new image treatments.

Bodenprobe clearly illustrates the trend towards seeking out smaller and unspectacular elements in the landscape and showcasing them in such a way that their unfamiliarity within the surrounding landscape is enhanced still further by photographic means and emphases.

Photographer and father-to-be Kurt Hörbst used his large-format camera to follow his wife at close range during her pregnancy. The reportage-like photographs taken in different locations seem strange given the slow pace of the medium, depicting an almost filmic sequence that addresses issues such as loneliness, uncertainty and joyful anticipation, unrest and calm, curiosity, anxiety and pride. In a flurry of colour snapshots towards the end of the book, 5070 resolves itself as the newborn baby's weight.

The Lives of the Unholy are a visual archaeology of the city of Warsaw, an attempt at looking closely at the phenomenon of the destruction of monuments in Poland in times of political transformation, Today the fact that Warsaw was rebuilt after the war as a promise of a social utopia is practically invisible. Its post-war roots have become hieroglyphs. This book is an attempt at a visual reading of the city's hidden grammar, of the mute language it speaks.



Valentina Seidel's new work entitled Eigen Brot features portraits and still-lifes of creative outsiders within our society. She photographed sculptors. poets, painters and bon vivants living on the margins of our general awareness. Seidel is fascinated by the artistic collaboration with people for whom individuality and their own artistic practice are part of the expression of their personality. The photographs were taken over a period of four years in an intense, process-based dialogue with the persons portrayed, in their living environment. SUSPENDED is about processing existing images that represent our visual image of the world—and examining their reducibility to the bare essentials. This radical "distillation" process generates new beautiful abstract images—yet they carry the very last traces of a former figurative picture.

Kopal comprises 1,224 Polaroids taken by Frank Mädler. Over a period of many years, since 1996, he has photographed his surroundings, his neighbourhood, and his milieu – until 2012 when his stocks of Polaroid film ran out. In a departure from his large-format photographs, the artist's mindset for Kopal focused on small images, catalogued in different ways in the index: both chronologically, i.e. just as they appear in the book, and alphabetically, but also according to his own whimsical categories. So despite the multitude of photographs, tracking down certain images is simplicity enough, all of which makes for an interesting, self-charted voyage of discovery through the book, through time and through Frank Mädler's environment.



Origins, memory and photography "I'm often asked: 'Why do your photographs look so old? Are you nostalgic?' It's quite the opposite: if you're nostalgic, you long for the past, but I've spent my whole life trying to detach myself from the past. As a child, back then in the post-war period, I began collecting mental images. As a five-year-old I witnessed brutal scenes of slaughtering, but there was no-one I could talk to about them. Later on I unconsciously searched for, found and photographed the mental images of my childhood. They allowed me to see through what I had not understood and free myself from deeply rooted experiences." O.T.
